# ABOUT THE GHAPP 2024 CONFERENCE



### **COURSE OVERVIEW**

The objective of the 2024 GHAPP conference is to bring together APPs for an in-depth clinical update, to foster an interactive discussion on the latest scientific and clinical developments, and to review important current concepts in the multidisciplinary treatment of patients with GI disorders and chronic liver disease. The conference will exclusively feature expert APP speakers and offer a combined plenary and small-group learning environment to facilitate interaction between attendees and faculty on the most clinically relevant topics, including viral hepatitis, NASH, cirrhosis, and GI disorders, including IBD, IBS, and OIC.

- There are more than 290,000 nurse practitioners (NPs) licensed in the United States.1
- 89.7% of NPs are certified in an area of primary care, and 69.0% of all NPs deliver primary care.<sup>2</sup>
- The majority of NPs (57.4%) see three or more patients per hour.<sup>3</sup>
- By 2026, the Bureau of Labor Statistics projects that the NP role will have grown by 36% compared to 13% for physicians (this excludes anesthesiologists and surgeons).<sup>4</sup>

### **CONFERENCE ORGANIZER**

For the purpose of this document, GHAPP, Focus Medical Communications, and Tactical Advantage Group will be referred to as the Conference Organizer.

### REPORTABLE EXPENSES

The Conference Organizer attests that sponsorship funds will not be used to purchase meals, snacks, or beverages for any conference or event attendee. The Conference Organizer also attests that sponsorship funds will not be used toward faculty honoraria for the duration of this conference.

### **PAYMENT TERMS**

Confirmation of your sponsorship/exhibit space is contingent upon receiving full payment prior to the scheduled event date. Payment instructions will be provided in a confirmation email upon submission of this form. Payment due in full upon signing.

### **CANCELLATION POLICY**

A refund, minus a handling fee of 10%, will be given for cancellations received in writing within three business days after the Sponsorship/Exhibitor's Agreement is completed. After this date, no refunds will be granted unless the conference is canceled altogether.

If the conference is postponed and rescheduled within one year of the originally scheduled date, no refunds will be granted.
