Did you know the EBP/R Committee invites abstract submissions across EBP, quality improvement, process, evaluation, program development, historical review, and more? Watch your email and newsletters for information on the abstract submission window, planned categories (disease state, health policy, practice, etc.), prizes, and author guidance. Submissions will be peer-reviewed. Accepted abstracts will be displayed at the 2022 GHAPP Annual Conference as posters. Last year, the top prize for best abstract was a \$100 Amazon gift card!

As a service to the GHAPP community of members, the EBP/R Committee will be sending a **needs assessment survey** later this year. We would like to capture information on what interests you as a GHAPP member, what type of programming you wish to have, and what needs you may have related to becoming the best gastroenterology and/or hepatology provider possible. This information will be used to help GHAPP leadership ensure your needs are met across clinical learning, career advancement/enhancement, project dissemination, and more. Our very own **Barbra Cave, Ph.D., APRN** was published with an esteemed group of hepatologists. The article, "A simplified algorithm for managing hepatitis C infection by leveraging telemedicine" is published in January 2022 in *Gastroenterology & Hepatology: Open Access*. As the title suggests, the paper discusses best practices for addressing and managing hepatitis C infections using a telehealth model. Information is tailored for primary care and other non-specialist providers.

HIGHLIGHTS FROM THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING

In January 2022, BOT members met in New Orleans, Louisiana. Members discussed feedback from the 2021 GHAPP National Conference, 2022 conference planning, and other GHAPP ventures. GHAPP Committee leaders presented ideas for committee membership, current action items, and by-laws. 2021 conference feedback was utilized to build the 2022 conference.

This year's conference will offer more combination plenary sessions, opportunities to dive deeper into the sub-specialties of IBD and Hepatology with Boot Camps, skill strengthening sessions on non-clinical topics, and a 2-hour block of professional development workshop, and a 2-hour evidence-based practice workshop. The "Point Taken Pods" (used in 2021), will again be available in 2022 and will provide feedback on presentation skills. In addition, social engagement will be a focus. Like last year, a yoga class will be offered. This class is popular, so sign up early! We are planning another fun-filled activity, perhaps something Nashville-themed (is anyone up for line dancing?). More details on this to come.

In line with GHAPP's mission and vision, we are pursuing options for continuing education to support our colleagues. Regional meetings will be held again this year, with 8 locations across the country.
